Active Duty Soldiers must have a referral when seeking urgent care.


If you are an active duty service member living in a Prime Service Area, you must seek care at a military hospital or clinic.

COVID-19 Delta Variant

The Delta variant has spread throughout the world and is now a variant of concern in the U.S. where it is rapidly expanding, especially in areas where vaccination rates are low. The Delta variant:

- is more transmissible
- causes more severe disease
- results in higher cases of hospitalization and death than any other strain

The Delta variant is the NEW REASON for beneficiaries to get vaccinated!

- Unvaccinated and partially-vaccinated people are at real risk
- Fully vaccinated individuals are protected.
- Two doses of the mRNA vaccines are effective against the Delta variant.
- The most important action beneficiaries can take right now to prevent the spread of this variant is to get vaccinated.
- Beneficiaries who have had their first dose are reminded to get their second dose.

Retiring Soon?

Are you Retiring or Separating from the Military?

For Soldiers planning on filing a VA disability claim:

Initiate your claim by enrolling in e-benefits prior to separating from active duty service. The e-benefits website link:

HTTPS://WWW.EBENEFITS.VA.GOV/EBENEFITS-PORTAL/EBENEFITS.PORTAL.

- After enrolling in e-benefits, the VA will contact you to setup a date to complete the SHPE. You are responsible for ensuring that the SHPE occurs within 180 days before the date of separation.
- The Leavenworth VAMC will conduct the Compensation and Pension Exam (VAMC C&P), which is the equivalent to a SHPE. A military retirement physical is NOT required for a VAMC C&P exam. The retiring or separating service member requires only ONE examination if they complete the VAMC C&P exam.
- Notify the Readiness Center at MAHC within 30 days of separation that your VAMC C&P exam is complete and Readiness Center staff will complete the SHPE from the VAMC C&P exam without an appointment.


